

# YOU HAVE RIGHTS!

As a Resident of an Assisted Living Facility

## RESPECT and DIGNITY

You have the right to be treated with courtesy, respect and consideration as a person of worth, sensitivity, and dignity.

## CHOICES

You have the right to make choices about your care and daily life, finances, social and religious activities and other matters.

## PRIVACY

You have the right to privacy in your care, personal matters, visits with guests and mail.

## INFORMATION

You have the right to be informed of and give input regarding your care plan. Know your rights and responsibilities (*ask the administrator for a copy of your rights*).

## PREFERENCES

You have the right to have reasonable preferences accommodated.

## GRIEVANCE

You have the right to make a complaint without fear of punishment or retaliation.

## PROTECTION FROM UNFAIR DISCHARGE

You have a right to file a complaint or appeal if you feel you are being unfairly discharged.
